ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A SECTION OF NORTH POPLAR STREET TO JUSTICE CENTER DRIVE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Little Rock (the "City") is currently in the process of constructing a new Justice Building currently located along North Poplar Street; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to rename approximately 235 feet of North Poplar to Justice Center Drive (see maps collectively attached hereto as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, notice has been sent to surrounding property owners and a legal advertisement of notice of a public hearing to be held January 27, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. has been placed in the newspaper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That approximately 235 feet of North Poplar Street between 1-40 and East Pershing Boulevard, as designated on Exhibit A attached hereto, is renamed Justice Center Drive.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.


