A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 8148 WHICH DECLARED 11 BAKER CIRCLE IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE AND CONDEMNED IT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
