A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS TO UTILIZE FEDERAL AID FUNDS FOR THE LEVY AND PARK HILL JUMP START IMPROVEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS WITH THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTION (ARDOT); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2013, with the adoption of Resolution 8408, the North Little Rock City Council expressed its support of application to Metroplan for Jump Start project funds for the revitalization and repurposing of existing communities and committed funds for the study of certain City of North Little Rock ("City") neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2016, the North Little Rock City Council passed Resolution No. 9027, approving and accepting the Jump Start implementation plans for revitalization of and improvements to the Park Hill and Levy neighborhoods in the City of North Little Rock; and

WHEREAS, Metroplan has recently approved Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant Program—Attributable funds for the project at the following Federal and City participating ratios, up to the maximum Federal-aid available (see chart below); and
