Comcast Cable TV Franchise Agreement Renewal Request

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Cable Television Franchise Renewal

The North Little Rock City Council will hold a public hearing in response to a request by Comcast, the current cable operator, for a cable television franchise renewal agreement. The hearing will be held Monday, April 9, 2018 at 6:00pm at the North Little Rock City Hall, 300 Main Street, North Little Rock, Arkansas, in the Council Chambers. This hearing will be held pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1934, as amended. The City is required by federal and state law to consider the ability of the applicant to: (I) Meet its financial obligations to perform; (II) Provide adequate and technically sound facilities, equipment and signal quality; (III) Provide adequate channel capacity and appropriate facilities for public, educational, or governmental use, taking into account available technology, subscriber interest, and cost; (IV) Prohibit discrimination among customers of basic service; (V) Provide reasonable service quality in terms of available technology, subscriber interest, and cost; (VI) Construct and install cable-related equipment which conforms to all applicable state and federal laws and regulations and the National Electric Safety Code; (VII) Provide a competent staff able to provide prompt, adequate service and to respond comprehensively to customer complaints or problems; and (VIII) Provide reasonable rules and policies for line extensions and disconnects, customer deposits, and billing practices.

All members of the public are encouraged to attend and speak, if they wish to do so.
