

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS TO UTILIZE FEDERAL AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDS FOR THE BISHOP LINDSEY STREETScape PROJECT FROM LOCUST STREET TO VINE STREET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2016, the North Little Rock City Council passed Resolution No. 9012, expressing the willingness of the City of North Little Rock (the "City") to utilize Federal Aid Transportation Alternatives Program ("TAP") funds at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop or improve the streetscape of Bishop Lindsey Avenue from Vine Street to Hickory Street; and

WHEREAS, Shorter College previously submitted a TAP application to utilize TAP funds to improve the streetscape of Bishop Lindsey Avenue from Locust Street to Vine Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Arkansas Department of Transportation and the City that it will be more efficient and cost effective to develop and construct the Bishop Lindsey Avenue streetscape improvement project as one project as opposed to two projects (see map and drawing attached hereto as Exhibit A and Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the City understands that TAP Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop or improve the streetscape of Bishop Lindsey Avenue from Locust Street to Vine Street; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that Federal Aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the City of North Little Rock for the life of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of the Bishop Lindsey Streetscape Project (Locust Street to Vine Street).

SECTION 2: That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite construction of the

above stated improvement, said agreements and contracts to be reviewed by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3: That the North Little Rock City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, to cooperate with the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

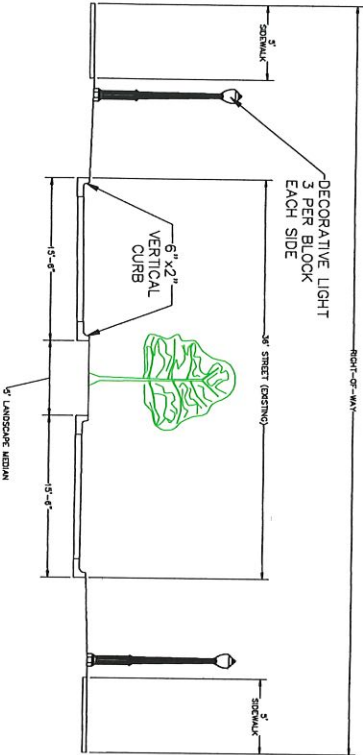
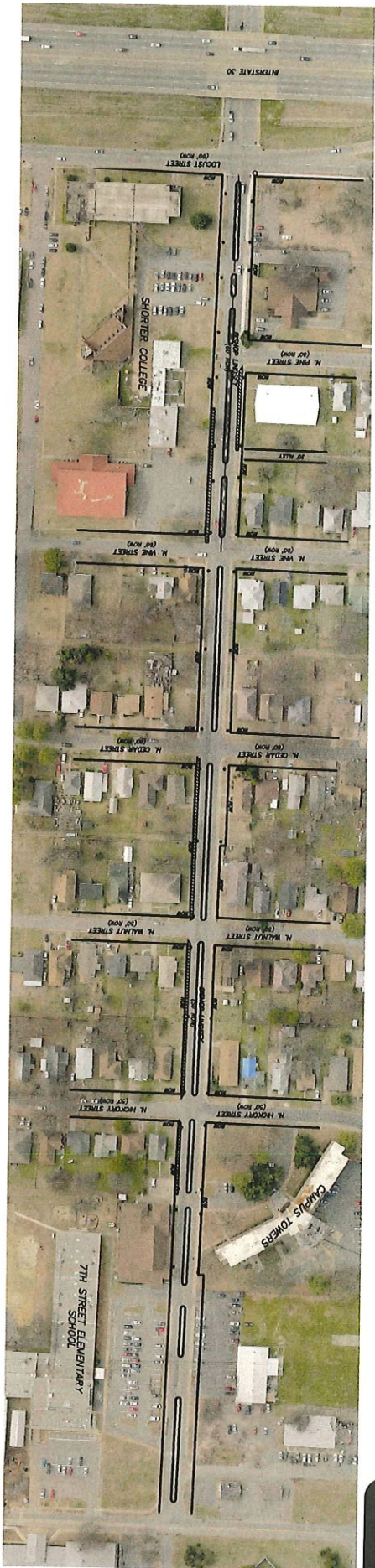
