

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION APPROVING SALARY INCREASES TO ALL FULL-TIME SALARIED EMPLOYEES (EXCLUDING UNIFORMED POLICE PERSONNEL AND ELECTED OFFICIALS), ALL FIRE PERSONNEL AND THE POLICE CHIEF OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of North Little Rock wishes to provide a 2.2% salary increase, effective August 11, 2018, for all full-time non-uniformed, salaried and unclassified employees of the City (excluding uniformed police personnel and elected officials), all fire personnel and the police chief; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of North Little Rock that such raises be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That all full-time, non-uniformed, salaried and unclassified employees (excluding uniformed police personnel and elected officials), all fire personnel and the police chief are hereby granted a 2.2% increase in base salary, effective August 11, 2018.

SECTION 2: That the salary increases contemplated by this Resolution are subject to and contingent upon the appropriation of sufficient funding by City Council to be included in a budget amendment.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
