In an article in the Arkansas Democrat Gazette dated September 21, 2018, a price increase in 2019 and another in 2020 for recycling was outlined. The article stated the current price as \$2.99, and the first increased price to be \$4.14, and the next to be \$4.29 per month. There was also discussion about glass no longer being accepted.

It is upsetting that the residents of North Little Rock face price increases along with limitations to the current acceptable items. It would seem logical that with an increase in the charge there would be more types of items accepted for recycling.

I am a lifelong resident of North Little Rock, and I care deeply about the city. I have volunteered in many capacities in the city since the age of thirteen, and I continue to volunteer.
