Updates

- 1. Patio Park Hill event was a HUGE success. Lots of great stats: 1495 paid adult attendees, ~500 kid attendees, 25 vendors, BMX stunt show, NLR School of Dance performance, 3 live bands, 8 food trucks, over 2000 total attendance including vendors and volunteers, raised over \$4000. Next Patio event will be in September.
- 2. Levy Trail received TAP (Transportation Alternative Program) funding to take the trail to 56th St. Amount is \$42,000 with an 80/20 match. The design is already complete so funding will pay for construction: grading, drainage, paving, and lighting).

What's coming up?

- 1. NLR Municipal Air & Car Show Saturday, June 25th gates on Maryland Ave open at 9 am, airshow noon 3 pm adults \$5, kids 8 and under are free
- 2. Patio Park Hill next event will be in September
- 3. Jump Start Your Block event July 16th from 8 am 5 pm, 33rd St between Marion and Sycamore. Event will focus on small home improvement projects requested by residents, also curb cleaning/weed whacking, installing house numbers, installing smoke alarms, signing residents up for home energy audits
- 4. There will be a Focus event occurring in Levy very soon (date TBD). Flyers will be sent out approx. two weeks in advance. Flyers will also be placed in the target area and city staff will go door to door to speak to residents. Focus event will "focus" on street lights, pot holes, litter, and other code issues. After Focus event department heads will make recommendations to Mayor.
- 5. Juan Carlos Posadas announced that there will be a church camp coming up soon. More details to come.
