Updates

- 1. Metroplan RFQ/RFP went out recently. 9 responses were received and are qualifications are being checked. The original Jump Start committee will be called back together to reassess each project (next 2-4 weeks). Then firms will write a scope of work, likely by end of September. The most projects a firm will get is 2. Selection committee composed of project jurisdictions, AHTD, and Metroplan. By end of October AHTD receives negotiated contracts to review. Metroplan will invoice NLR for 20% engineering match after scope of work is submitted from engineering firms.
- 2. City of NLR has begun putting back money to cover the 20% match for the engineering and construction phases of the projects
- 3. Bernadette will be posting the Park Hill Business Survey results on the Jump Start website.
- 4. PHBMA plans to develop some focus groups to follow up on what was learned through the survey process.
- 5. Aldermen and Jump Start project team plan to meet with NLRSD administration to discuss the Park Hill Elementary property and discuss its importance to the continuation of success and additional funding through Metroplan.
- 6. Question came up regarding whether or not private citizens are able to get an option on the PH Elementary property to allow time to work on a solution.
- 7. Rock Region Metro Annual Service Enhancement Evaluation, 14 of 26 routes affected (in NLR: McAlmont & Levy), moving forward with no cost change implementation and requests from riders based on public comments. The results are all online. Board will vote on route changes. 25 more shelters coming in.
