Consider location for event, i.e. $33^{\text {rd }}$ and Cherry Hill has had issues with crime, as has southern Levy in general

Using sidewalks helps - won't need to close off roads
Officer is needed anywhere near the interstate off ramp
Barricades can be used on lesser roads
Need to identify all sidewalks in area and see if we can make a route with those
$F$ is safer than $33^{\text {rd }}$ for racers
If we use sidewalks, racers HAVE to stop for traffic
PD assistance - no application, hire officers, have a conversation with Lt Breckon, discuss needs, discuss costs of everything involved, then come to agreement about final cost for PD involvement, officers have a contractual 3 hour minimum at $\$ 45 / h r / o f f i c e r$

Use Google Earth to build routes and calculate distance
If we don't need to block streets then we don't need officers, however can consider using officers for general safety and security

Consider using Ridge Road for parking and start/finish location
Submit route to Shirley if pretty similar to the one developed by Lt Breckon in our meeting
Lt Breckon's route - Levy Trail to $47^{\text {th }}$ to Ridge Road to Cherry Hill to Poplar to D to Fiesta to F to $35^{\text {th }}$ to Levy Trail (see map -5.2 km )

Heard back from a friend at a local not for profit who said that they do not have funds to pay vendor fees. Think we need for profit vendor fee of $\$ 100$ and not for profit vendor fee of $\$ 0-\$ 25$ on a case by case basis.

Created budget showing everything we might need for the race, plus what it would cost to buy it (mostly online research), a column for what we actually pay or what is donated, and who donated it. At bottom built formals to show our overall profit based on what we spend versus what we bring in from full event registrations and mini mile registrations.

Family Fun Run registration $=\$ 20$ and Mini Mile registration $=\$ 10$
Created to do list with lots of tasks that still need doing, including column for person responsible and notes. Will share link. PLEASE DO NOT DELETE ANYTHING, BUT USE
FORMAT $\rightarrow$ STRIKETHROUGH to show something as being completed or no longer needed.
Eventbrite package that we would need for this event would cost us $\$ 1.99$ per registration PLUS $2.5 \%$ of total income to use. Don't want to charge more than $\$ 20 / \$ 10$ for two runs, which means we would only recoup about $\$ 15 / \$ 6$ or so? Going to look into two other platforms to see how they compare. Also, won't open registration until we get official OK from NLRPD and Neighborhood Services regarding our event application.
Need everyone to look at to do list and see if there are different sections that you want to take on. We need a lot of help, but REALLY NEED a volunteer chair, sponsorship/donations chair, health fair chair, registration chair. Please let me know which position you are interested in filling. If you don't want an entire position then which specific task items are you interested in?

James will handle health fair if we are able to secure the Park Hill Baptist Recreation Center for an indoor space.
Jenna is meeting with Mark Dewbre on Wednesday morning to discuss event details and get confirmation of church involvement

Current route according to James' run (thanks James!) was 3.4 miles. He will run again and cut off short section on H to see what that does to distance.

Potential intersection issues (consider barricades, cones, additional volunteers, etc.) are at:
